

FOOD ALLERGY TEAM RESPONSIBILITIES

Food allergies can be life threatening. The risk of accidental exposure to foods can be reduced in the school setting if schools work with students, parents and physicians to minimize risks and provide a safe environment for foodallergic students. In that regard, FWISD Child Nutrition Services expects the following division of responsibilities:

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x Provide written medical documentation and instructions as directed by a physician using the form provided by FWISD

x Educate the child in the selfmanagement of their food allergy including:

- x Be prepared to take emergency action for student in the cafeteria in the event of an allergic reaction.

- x Attend the campus food allergy management team meetings.

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- x Inform parents and school nurse of any school events where food will be served.
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
